**PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE OF MARTIN COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD
TO AUDIT VOTING EQUIPMENT**

The Martin County Canvassing Board will meet at 5 pm on Thursday, November 9, 2017, for the purpose of conducting a voting system audit as required by Florida Statutes. The audit shall consist of a public manual tally of the votes cast from one randomly selected race and one randomly selected precinct, from the November 7, 2017, Special Referendum Election. This meeting will be held at the Supervisor of Elections office located at 135 SE Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, Stuart. The Canvassing Board will meet until the audit has been concluded.

In accordance with the Sunshine Law of Florida, this meeting will be open to the public.

Section 286.0105, Florida Statutes, states if a person decides to appeal any decision by a board, agency, or commission with respect to any matter considered at a meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
